21 August 2018 - Opening of World Meeting of Families 2018

Simultaneous National Opening of WMOF2018 in all dioceses in Ireland

22 to 24 August 2018 - World Meeting of the Families Pastoral Congress

Keynote speakers, workshops and discussions; exhibitions, art and cultural activities, daily celebration of the Eucharist, liturgical and prayerful activities. Each day will reflect on the theme "The Gospel of the Family: Joy for the World" chosen by the Holy Father. The venue has been confirmed as the **RDS, Ballsbridge, Dublin 4**

Evening of 25 August - Festival of Families

A festive time, where we gather to celebrate the gift of family from the perspective of the specific theme of the World Meeting. This will be a cultural celebration of music, dance, song, within a prayerful and joyful setting, and with the aid of stories given by families from different parts of the world.
