WORLD MEETING OF FAMILIES 2018 FESTIVAL OF FAMILIES AT A GLANCE

Festival of Families (Saturday 25th August 2018) 6.30PM

One of the most significant and beautiful events within every World Meeting of Families is the *Festival of Families*, a very special concert-type event which, at its heart, celebrates families and their faith from all around the world. It will be a warm, moving, deeply engaging and unforgettable experience – a very special occasion to attend in person or watch from around the world.

On the evening of Saturday, 25th August, WMOF2018 will welcome Pope Francis and over 70,000 people to share the joy of the *Festival of Families* celebrations in Croke Park Stadium. This two-hour festival is choreographed as a celebration of family life and will be one of the highlights of the WMOF2018, with music, song, dance, and spoken word.

The selection of themes reflects many of the priorities in the ministry of Pope Francis, including homelessness and those on the margins; migrants and refugees; care for our common home; and the importance of the family, peace, and love throughout the world. The stage design for the event will include a “circle of encounter”, where families will sit with Pope Francis to watch some of the presentations on stage.

The *Festival of Families* also brings together an exciting line-up of creative and performance talent in a cast of thousands, featuring a host of contemporary Irish and international singers, performers, choirs, musicians, dancers, as well as hundreds of volunteers, together creating a unique experience. It promises to be a very special event.
