
### **WMOF SPECIAL COLLECTION**

A National Collection to help defray the costs of the recent World Meeting of Families and the visit of Pope Francis will take place in all churches in Ireland **over the weekend of 10<sup>th</sup>/11<sup>th</sup> November**. This will replace the usual second collection for Share.

The overall cost to the Church in Ireland for hosting the World Meeting comes to €19.4m. To date €15.4m has been raised by way of local church collections and by other donations. This leaves us with a deficit of €4m.
