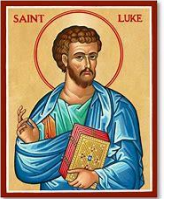

LIVING WITH LOSS

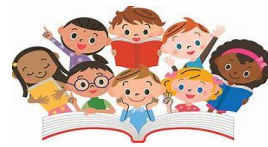
